The Earth Science Museum (ESM) was founded in July 2011 to replace and expand the mission of the closed Arizona Mining and Mineral Museum. The ESM received 501(c)(3) status in June 2012 (retroactive to July 2011), and is moving forward with plans for a new Museum in the Phoenix area.

In its first year of operation, the ESM developed two new teacher kits. These kits feature large rock, mineral, and fossil specimens along with educational materials linked to current Arizona science curriculum standards.

They are complemented by classroom instruction delivered by trained, volunteers. Each school receives at no charge a set of kits with a scheduled presentation. In the 2011-2012 school-year, the kits and classroom instruction were successfully piloted at 17 local schools involving 1,584 students.
