Arizona Gives Day March 20, 2013 Mark your calendar!

The Earth Science Museum will participate in the first Arizona Gives Day on March 20th.

The Alliance of Arizona Nonprofits in partnership with the Arizona Grantmakers Forum, is sponsoring AZ Gives Day. This is a one day, statewide, online movement to raise as much money as possible for the state's nonprofits.

The Earth Science Museum's mission is to establish and innovative, world-class destination museum in the Phoenix area dedicated to inspiring all generations about earth sciences.

Your contribution will set the stage for the new Earth Science Museum that will be developed in three phases. Our first phase focuses on outreach programs where hands-on classroom instruction and educational kits with rocks, fossils and minerals are brought to schools. Phase two features an initial facility with the first permanent mineral displays that will include the Flagg Mineral Collection. Phase three expands to a full-featured facility that will include interactive exhibits covering the major fields of earth science, such as geology, geophysics, geochemistry, oceanography, paleontology and physical geography.
