



Arizona Rocks 48

Here is a book that I just recently found called *Arizona Rocks*. (What a great title!). It is a guide to geologic sites in the Grand Canyon State, written by T. Scott Bryan, and published in 2013. I found it on Amazon used for \$7 to \$15. The new list price is \$18. It has short introduction to the geology of Arizona and 44 sites to visit. For each site it has a map and a number of photographs with a description of the geology. Some of the locations have been covered in the ESM newsletters, but it has many more and a number that I have never visited. I recommend this for anyone wanting to find interesting geological places to visit in Arizona.

Two other books about the geology of Arizona (the whole state versus the many books about specific parts of the state) are *Roadside Geology of Arizona* by Halka Chronic published first in 1983. I found it at Amazon for 99 cents to \$30. The second is *Geology of Arizona* by Nations and Stump published in 1981. It was on Amazon for \$4 to \$72.
